OLD BUSINESS

2. Approve Sept Treasurer’s Reports – Motion by Brandenburg to approve September Treasurer’s Report; Second by Lorensen; All in favor - approved
3. Fall Appreciation event -Final details-who is coming? Spread the word – board members planning to attend; Dana working on the catering menu; bring door prizes if you’re planning to donate; Dana and Cindy working on the centerpieces
4. Fall workshop/event-update. Set date? Dana discussing with Cy – may not be feasible to do a composting event this fall; still have a lot of planning to do; Cy suggested recording a video and put the word out for a compost event in the spring, maybe around Earth Day – possible demo at the library or outdoors at Rhylander Park
5. Pumpkins recycling/compost update-Hosanna Lutheran – Dana called their contact and they seemed receptive to allowing people to drop off their pumpkins; will need to confirm with Pastor when he returns from travelling
6. Update on Tax exempt status- Dana confirmed that our organization is not eligible for sales tax exemption
7. Trailer update – Dana picked up and registered the trailer; working with Cy to pick up recycling in Plattsmouth (St. John’s, Plattsmouth elementary, middle and high schools), that previously were using Duet; maybe ask to get student volunteers to help; pickup is logistically complicated; will the KCCB logo be placed on the side? Yes – will need to review designs; Dana looking for sponsors to help fund the trailer – Dana has approached Pinnacle Bank
8. Ambassador program/Photo program – Not moving anywhere – haven’t had any interest; maybe need to rethink the format – cater to a younger audience – offer a scholarship? Other social media options (Tik Tok) with video content instead of FB and photos
9. Strategic Planning Retreat (Rachel) – Annual discussions – maybe a brunch of the directors – brainstorming session – annual raises, other general topics for discussion;

goals, visions, expectations for the Executive Director; Rachel will send an email asking for those interested to join a sub-committee
