#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Dana gave an update of January activities. She reported that KCCB will be working with St. Johns to go Zero Waste for the Fish Fry events in a pilot program. 10 bags of cans and two large bins of glass and a bag of plastic were recycled at the Quack off. The Nextrex program for Elmwood is almost complete at over 900lbs/1,000 being collected already.
- 2. Memberships are up, two new members.
- 3. Dana submitted grant applications for PCFF and Midlands for Glass recycling. We received a \$950 grant from Nutrien for the Fair again this year.
- 4. Earth day/spring event-Dana is planning an Earth day event, hoping to have a tree donated to give away in a drawing for those who have done a litter cleanup in 2024, maybe Hy-Vee donate donuts or cookies, encourage people to take a walk/hike, pick up litter, give away flowers and flower packets.
- 5. Next meeting Louisville Senior Center- All in agreement.
- 6. Adopt a Spot -Dana challenged all board members to join Adopt a Spot or at a minimum host 1 litter cleanup in 2024.
